WHY SHOULD WE USE REEF-SAFE SUNSCREEN?

Sunscreen is widely used when swimming, diving and snorkelling.

Yet, studies have shown some **chemical compounds in sunscreen** - including **Oxybenzone and Octinoxate** - may harm coral reefs, even in very small doses

When wearing sunscreen while in the water, **it can wash off and enter the water** which could **harm coral reefs**

These chemicals have been shown to cause:
bleaching, harm coral DNA, interfere with coral reproduction in lab-based studies
